FIDO (Dog & Pet) REGISTRATIONS

As you would be aware, pets are now permitted in Fingal Bay, Shoal Bay and Halifax Holiday Parks at all times, including Peak Periods. There are no restrictions as to when you can bring your pet(s) onsite.

However, there are restrictions in place for during the Summer School Holidays period.

As Holiday Van Owners are generally the most regular users of the Parks, we are requesting notification of all pets being brought onsite by way of this registration form. (Please note: all tourist bookings are asked if they're bringing Pets and which breeds, and are given the same information regarding Park policy and rules as are included here for Holiday Van Owners. They also sign a Guest Registration agreement prior to arrival which states they will abide by all the Park rules.)

Pet Rules & Information are below the form. Please observe the Summer Holiday restrictions.

- Please be aware that not everyone is a dog/animal lover, so tact and consideration for others must be observed. On the flip side, some dogs/animals are wary of humans/children they don't know or see running towards them.
- Please **do not** leave your fur-baby(s) at the van alone, as a howling, crying, barking dog is very unpleasant to be near.
- Anyone taking pets for a walk **must be in control of the animal at all times**, and **MUST** pick up any doggie excrement and dispose of it in garbage bins. Please make sure your children know the rules!!
- Leaving the mess behind for someone else to find and deal with is neither fair, nor moral.
- Bags are available for this purpose – please ask our Parks staff for the location of the bags.

Fido Friendly Parks

***IMPORTANT NOTE:** You must check with Park Management BEFORE bringing your Fido into the park.

Did you know that Shoal Bay Holiday Park, Fingal Bay Holiday Park and Halifax Holiday Parks love dogs?... so let Fido enjoy a holiday with you when you're camping or caravanning at a Beachside Holiday Park.

Here's a couple of things you have to ponder:

- Your Fido can stay anytime of the year
- Only 1 Fido per reservation can stay during ALL School Holidays and Public Holidays
- No Fidos allowed at Thowalla Sunset Retreat or the Port Stephens Koala Sanctuary

Rules

If you are wanting to book in with Fido here are the rules to follow that will keep everyone happy

- Please advise park staff **PRIOR** to your arrival date if you wish to bring your Fido
- Fido's are only allowed when staying in your own Van or Tent
- Fido is to be Vaccinated and Registered
- Fido needs to have the approval of the Park Manager so you need to tell us Fido's breed and size
- **No restricted breeds** will be allowed at any time (*Pit Bull, American Pit, Japanese Tosa and Argentinian Fighting dog*)
- Fido is not permitted onsite if a Control Order is in place
- Fido need to be kept on a lead and under control at all times
- Fido is not permitted around the childrens play areas, in the pool area, amenities block or any of the communal areas.
- All Fido's poop are the responsibility of the owners and must be cleaned up immediately. Bags are located around the park to assist with this
- Excessive barking will not be tolerated - Fido not to be left unattended in your van or tent at any time
- Check our website for information about dog friendly areas near the parks.

Have a great holiday with Fido but please obey the rules or you may be asked to leave the park

So if your best friend likes to swim in the water, run on the beach and sleep all day I'm sure he or she will have a perfect holiday in one of our Port Stephens Beachside Holiday Parks. If you would like some more information please give one of the parks a ring and they will be happy to discuss your options.

**If you have a Registered Assistance, Therapy, Companion or Guide Dog the rules are slightly different so you will need to phone the park directly and discuss your specific needs. All our properties have assisted living cabins that are fitted out to industry specs that will hopefully suit your needs.*
