Your call will be logged, triaged and dealt with accordingly. If your call relates to a noise or behavior issue of another site, you - as the caller - will <b>not</b> be charged the after hours call out fee, it would be the perpetrator who gets charged. They will be notified of this by the Manager on-call.
General Park reminders:
All Park rules apply even during the winter months.
<ul> <li>No fires are permitted in our Parks.</li> <li>All tourists are being reminded of this too, and notices have been posted around the park.</li> </ul>

Tap n Go washers and dryers are in operation across all Park laundries. Most machines will also take tokens, however there are some in the Fingal Gooyah street laundry that are Tap N Go only. The price has increased to \$5 per load.

## Quarterly Electricity Charges - 1st Quarter of 2023/2024

Electricity meter reads will be conducted, invoices prepared & emailed prior to the school holidays commencing, and will include charges for July to September 2023.

Electricity charges are charged quarterly in line with current market rates. Charges will be applied to your accounts on the basis of consumption at the same rate as domestic customers of the local energy supplier including daily availability charges.
