

## Quick look at Level 1 Water Restrictions

Here's a quick look at Level 1 water restrictions

### WATERING LAWNS AND GARDENS

Only watering the garden before 10 am or after 4 pm, using a hose with a trigger nozzle.



#### Hard surfaces

No hosing of hard surfaces such as concrete, paths and driveways.



#### No sprinklers or irrigation systems

No sprinklers or irrigation systems.



#### Wash your vehicle using a trigger nozzle

All hoses must have a trigger nozzle

## What's allowed under Level 1 Water Restrictions?

### WATERING LAWNS AND GARDENS

You can:

- To avoid the heat of the day, water lawns and gardens with a handheld hose before 10 am and after 4 pm if fitted with a trigger nozzle or device that can be turned off instantly

You can't:

- Use any sprinklers or irrigation systems at any time
- Leave hoses or taps running unattended

### CLEANING EXTERNAL HARD SURFACES (PATHS, DRIVEWAYS & CONCRETE)

You can:

- Spot clean for safety, health or emergency reasons with a hose fitted with a trigger nozzle or with high-pressure cleaning equipment

You can't:

- Use a hose for general cleaning of hard surfaces such as paths, driveways and paved areas
- Leave hoses and taps running unattended

### WASHING VEHICLES AND BUILDINGS

You can:

- Wash vehicles, boats and building at any time if using a bucket, high-pressure cleaning equipment or a hose fitted with a trigger nozzle

Tip: washing your car on the grass is a great way to also water your lawn.

You can't:

- Wash vehicles, boats and buildings using a hose without a trigger nozzle.
